It was exciting to see her; the family was not the same when she was away. While it was great to see her, it was equally sad to put her back on a plane to go back to frozen BYU Idaho.

## **December**

Club soccer is now on hiatus but the family is still at the soccer fields this time rooting for Corona del Sol High School. Dakota played in the Tempe Diablos Soccer Classic and gets his first Varsity game action. At the conclusion of that tournament Jeff and Trina boarded a plane going back to Orlando. Jeff has training for a week in Florida and Trina is going along for some much needed time off. They were able to spend a lot of time together and Jeff had a blast taking pictures of the Disney and Universal parks during the holidays. When they returned Tiffany had the pins removed from her finger and began her rehab. As one medical issue was resolved another began. Jeff's left shoulder is again causing him problems and he

has appointments with orthopedic surgeons for consultations, X-rays, and MRIs. As the year ends it is looking more and more like another shoulder surgery is in his future its just a matter of when. Finally Whitney arrived home just in time for the holidays to help decorate the Christmas tree and wrap the presents so Jeff doesn't have to.
